HINCK & MATTHEWS WIN VIC TANNY 5

Former T.U. All-American Paul Hinck easily outclassed the field setting a new course record at 26:52 by winning Vic Tanny's Oct. 30 five (5) mile race! Besides the winner's trophy, race director Paul Warshawsky presented Hinck with a Panasonic AM-FM Weathertron table radio.

Finishing twenty eighth (28th) overall out of sixty-nine (69) finishers, ten-year-old Sherry Matthews was not even challenged as she captured the women's division in 32:41. In addition to her trophy, Sherry was awarded a beautiful blanket, thermos, and umbrella in a leather carrying case.

Rich Lachowski was also blistering the course in 25:22, followed by Harry Anderson 4th in 26:46. Dave Mason, 5th, won the 30-34 division in 27:19, with Paul Anderson (10th) winning the 35-39 division in 28:02. Paul Warshawsky crossed the finish line in 28:25 for 11th, followed by Frank Hank Jr. (72nd) in 29:09, Randy Cole (17th) in 29:59, John Trame (18th) in 30:16, Jim Petiniot (20th) - 30:21 and Rick Trame Jr. (23rd) - 31:52. Sy Mah, 34th overall, won the 50 and over division in 31:56, while Ron Cole found the distance in 32:04 for 26th. Pat Gallaher was timed in 32:04 for 27th, followed by Fred Fineske (30th) in 32:39, Doyle Carpenter (33rd) - 33:07, Richard Blickle (34th) - 33:08, Art Johnson (38th) - 34:40, Steve Kaczor (39th) - 34:41, Richard Trame Sr. (40th) - 34:48, Pete Nordiba (41st) - 35:00, Lou Wagner (43rd) - 35:20, Eric Christiansen (48th) - 38:16, and Bob Morris (60th) - 45:42.

Lisa Rupp was second in the women's division in 35:19, followed by Toni Baker - 38:46, Sara Mason - 38:47, Amy Trame - 38:49, Marriane LaPoint - 40:30, Joann Gallaher - 45:21 and Terri LaPoint - 49:00.

In addition to the age group trophies, ten special effort awards were presented. Among the ten receiving these special awards were TRRC members Rick Trame, Dick Trame, F. Fineske, R. Blickle, E. Christensen and D. Carpenter.

In all, it was another superb Vic Tanny race directed by Paul Warshawsky. Paul's next race is Dec. 11th--don't miss it!

ANDERSON WINS NATIONAL 50 KM. CHAMPIONSHIP

Of the sixteen who started, only four were able to complete the 50 km. at Secor park Nov. 14th.

Paul Anderson averaged just over 5:30 a mile over the grueling 31 miles to capture 1st place in 3:27:21. Jim Petiniot was next in 4:11:45, with Sy Mah close behind in 4:34:00. Fred Fineske endured to finish in 5:10:12.

KOVACS AND BRYAN ADD TO THE RECORDS

Tom Kovacs finished 26:00 for the Turkey Trot 3 mile in 26:00-- exactly what he predicted. While Gary Bryan was the overall winner in 15:10! Toni Baker also got a turkey missing her prediction by only 7 seconds! Complete results of the 6 mile were not available to this writer at press time; however, other turkey winners in the six mile were Doyle Carpenter and Fred Fineske, both within 20 seconds of their predictions. Others completing the 24 laps on T.U.'s track were Omer Holman, Art Johnson, Dave Mason, John Gores, Paul Warshawsky, Walt Tucker, Lou Wagner, Pat Gallaher, Tony LaPoint and Steve Kaczor.

Bob Munson was able to complete the 3 mile after a long undiagnosed illness. We all wish Bob a continued, speedy recovery.
